PREREGISTRATION OF RESEARCH PRESENTED AT 6th, 7th AND 8th WCRI

We studied the prevalence of preregistration of empirical studies presented at the 6th, 7th and 8th World Conferences on Research Integrity. The prevalence did not improve over time and stagnates at 28%. The actual availability of preregistrations could not always be confirmed, but this increased from 44% to 88% of the studies that claimed to have preregistered. The associations with study and applicant characteristics, and reasons given for not preregistering, can be found in the <u>preprint of our study</u>. We conclude that researchers of research integrity should much more practice what they preach.
