

ABSTRACT NOTIFICATIONS

All abstract submitters were notified about the outcome of the abstract review in early December. Accepted abstract presenters will need to **register by February 3** to confirm their spot in the program. Please notify our program team immediately if your plans have changed and you are no longer able to attend or need to change presenters.

DOCTORAL FORUM

The Doctoral Forum provides an exciting, friendly and supportive environment for PhD students to share ideas and to interact with other research integrity scholars. PhD students interested in participating in the Doctoral Forum **must indicate this on their registration form**. They will subsequently receive instructions for their application that needs to be submitted **by March 31, 2026** at the latest. The application will be reviewed for suitability by the moderators. Capacity is limited to 16 (two groups of 8) and each selected PhD can present for 5-10 minutes followed by 20-25 minutes of discussion.

FOCUS TRACK HELP SHAPE A GLOBAL REPORTING STANDARD FOR AI DISCLOSURE IN RESEARCH

The Focus Track of WCRI2026 will work toward a Global Reporting Standard for AI Disclosure in Research, in partnership with [ISC](#), [COPE](#), [STM](#) and [GYA](#). We are launching the first consultation round from Dec 2025 to Feb 2026, to identify what we really need to ensure transparent, consistent disclosure of Generative AI use. We invite you—research integrity professionals and experts—to contribute your input in terms of needs, requirements and structure of such a standard. It will guide later development stages of the Vancouver Standard focused on content, taxonomies and refinement.
